# GAIL reports 56% increase in net profit for September quarter

**S**tate-owned gas utility GAIL (India) Ltd on Tuesday reported a 56% jump in its September quarter net profit as bumper earnings from gas transmission and marketing business offset petrochemical losses.

Standalone net profit of

₹2,404.89 crore in July-September, or ₹3.66 per share, was 54.4% higher than ₹1,537.07 crore, or ₹2.34 a share, profit in the same period last year, according to the company's stock exchange filing.

GAIL saw pre-tax earnings from its mainstay gas transportation business soar 82% to ₹1,290.65 crore in the second quarter of the current fiscal. Also, its pre-tax earnings from

the marketing of natural gas jumped almost 400% to ₹1,784.58 crore.

Losses in the petrochemical business narrowed to ₹160.61 crore from ₹346.22 crore in July-September 2022. Its revenue from operations dropped to ₹31,882.62 crore in July-September from ₹38,490.89 crore on lower gas prices.

During the quarter, GAIL's natural gas transmission vol-

ume stood at 120.31 million standard cubic metres per day in the second quarter of the current fiscal (2023-24) against 116.33 mmscmd in Q1, the company said in a statement.

Gas marketing volume stood at 96.96 mmscmd against 98.84 mmscmds in the previous quarter.

GAIL chairman and managing director Sandeep Kumar Gupta said that during the

quarter, the company has performed well, especially on the strength in the gas transmission segment, which will continue to perform better.

He said performance during the quarter was constrained due to lower realization in polymers and LPG, which are expected to be better going forward. Polymer and LPG production in Q2 was almost flat.

The company, he said,

incurred a capex of around ₹4,853 crore during the current half-year, mainly on pipelines, petrochemicals and equity to joint ventures.

At an investor call after the earnings announcement, GAIL director (finance) Rakesh Kumar Jain said the company hopes to exit FY24 with a gas transmission volume of 123-124 mmscmd. It was 107 mmscmd in FY23.



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# Gas transmission business lifts GAIL profit 87 per cent

State-run Gas Authority of India (GAIL) on Tuesday reported a 87 per cent year-on-year (y-o-y) jump in its consolidated net profit to ₹2,442 crore for the July-September quarter in FY24, aided by better performance of its gas transmission business. The country's largest gas utility's net profit in Q2 FY24 rose 36 per cent sequentially.

GAIL's consolidated total income in the September quarter stood at ₹33,255 crore as against ₹38,970 in Q2 FY23 and ₹33,001 crore in Q1 FY24. GAIL CMD, S K Gupta, said that the company has performed on the strength in the gas transmission segment which will continue to perform better.

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# GAIL profit surges 87%

**GAIL (INDIA) LTD'S CONSOLIDATED** net profit for the second quarter of the financial year 2023-24 rose to a whopping 87% to ₹2,442.2 crore from ₹1305 crore in the second quarter of last fiscal due to increase in its transmission volumes. The Q2FY24 net profit for the group was also up by 36% from the previous quarter.

The revenue from operations of the country's top distributor and transmitter of natural gas, however, fell by 15% to ₹33,049.68 crore in the three months ended September from ₹38,728.86 crore in the same period a year ago.

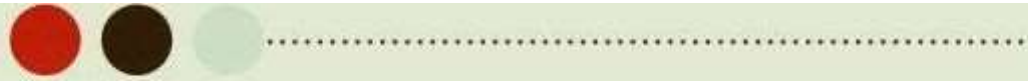

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# GAIL Q2 Profit Rises 56% on Marketing Business Boost

**New Delhi:** GAIL's quarterly profit soared 56% from a year earlier to ₹ 2,405 crore on a rebound in the natural gas marketing and transportation business.

Revenues for the July-September quarter dropped 19% to ₹31,823 crore on lower gas prices. "During the quarter, the company has performed well specially on the strength in gas transmission segment, which will continue to perform better," said Sandeep Kumar Gupta, chairman and managing director of GAIL. Realisations in the polymers and LPG business were lower during the quarter but will now get bet-

ter, he added. Last year, GAIL, the nation's top gas marketer and transporter, lost the supply of liquefied natural gas (LNG) from a key supplier, which hurt its sales and profits.



The LNG supply resumed this fiscal year, boosting GAIL's business. The company's operating profit from its natural gas transmission business rose 82% year-on-year to ₹1,291 crore during the quarter. The profit from the natural gas marketing business expanded nearly five times to ₹1,785 crore from ₹363 crore a year ago.— **Our Bureau**
